Ongoing Censorship of Palestinian Content


Incidents of digital violations against Palestinians have persisted, primarily stemming from actions emanating from social media companies. Throughout the month of March, 7amleh documented a total of 306 violations. These encompassed 51 instances of censorship, 255 cases involving the dissemination of violent and harmful content and behaviors on social media platforms.





Forms of Censorship on Palestinian Content in Social Media Platforms

Among the various forms of censorship imposed on Palestinian content, account suspensions and content removal are the most frequent measures. A total of 17 violations were recorded in the form of content removal, 13 cases of account suspension, 7 cases of account restriction, and 6 cases of shadow banning, while 8 other violations were distributed across different types of sanctions.

Among the forms of digitally harmful content and practices, most are in the form of hate speech and incitement

Out of a total of 255 documented violent contents, the Center for Campaigns recorded 136 violations related to inciting content, followed by 104 violations associated with hate speech, 10 cases with gender-based violence, and 5 violations involving account breaches and extortion.

Meta accounted for more Censorship and Spread of Harmful Content than any other Social Media Company

Center for Social Media Advancement during September were spread across various social media platforms. However, Meta's three main platforms accounted for the majority of violations, recording a total of 189 violations. Instagram accounted for 115 violations, Facebook for 73 violations, and WhatsApp for a single case.

Among other platforms, 7amleh documented 81 violations on X, 18 violations on Telegram, 14 violations on TikTok, 2 violations on YouTube, and 2 cases on other social media platforms.





The majority of pages and accounts that were subjected to violations belong to personal accounts

During the past month, personal accounts (profiles) were subjected to 26 violations involving restrictions and content removal, while pages recorded 23 violations, and channels 2 violations.


Regarding content containing hate speech, violence, and harmful digital practices, personal accounts (profiles) published 231 instances, pages 5 instances, channels 18 instances, and one instance on another account.





Digital Rights Violations in Jerusalem

Of all the violations of Palestinian digital rights, 7amleh documented 14 violations in Jerusalem.
